

HOSPITALITY In the Name of Christ Rules

The following rules are for anyone staying as part of the overnight shelter program. Rules are for everyone's safety, comfort and dignity. Any violation of these rules may result in termination of your participation in the program.

1. **NO SMOKING OR CHEWING TOBACCO** inside the building.
2. Once you have signed in, you are only allowed to leave the building during scheduled-supervised smoke breaks in a designated area.
3. **GUESTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BRING BEVERAGES TO THE SHELTER, INSIDE OR OUTSIDE.**
4. **NO DRUGS OR ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES ANYWHERE ON SHELTER PROPERTY.**
5. **ABSOLUTELY NO WEAPONS OF ANY KIND ARE PERMITTED!!!**
6. **NO PROFANITY** in the church. Please remember, you are in a house of God.
7. The church staff and volunteers are in charge of the building. Please direct any questions to them.
8. Men and women are assigned separate sleeping areas. Guests are not allowed in opposite gender sleeping areas.
9. NO pillows or personal bedding will be allowed into the shelter.
10. The church doors will open at 6pm every night. Doors will close at 8pm, with "Lights Out" at 10:30pm. The church doors will remain locked until 6:00am the next morning. (Special arrangements will be made for guests working later or going to work early in the morning).
11. No loitering at the shelter locations. Please do not arrive any earlier than 5:45pm.
12. Guests are required to assist with clean up and teardown of the shelter on Sunday morning.
13. No Pets.
14. No food or drink is allowed in the sleeping areas.
15. Please be respectful of the hosting church and do your part to keep the shelter neat and clean, as well as yourself! Hospitality will provide ample opportunities for showering throughout the week, you are expected to take advantage of this.
16. Wake up time is 6:30am with one smoke break at 6:45am. Breakfast is served at 7:00am. Depart by 8:00am. If you are a CSC offender your departure may be delayed, see Shelter Coordinator for details.
17. **All** of your personal belongings will need to be stored in the container supplied by Hospitality In the Name of Christ.
18. Medications cannot be left at the shelter. Take them with you when you leave for the day.
19. Neither Hospitality In the Name of Christ nor the hosting Church takes any responsibility for belongings left at the shelter.
20. The Family Gathering will be attended by all of the guests.
